POST OF CLASS TEACHER- MARINE PARK FIRST SCHOOL

Thank you for expressing an interest in the teaching posts at Marine Park First School.

Marine Park is a purpose built, PFI School on an extensive and attractive coastal site in Whitley Bay, North Tyneside. The school is the largest First School in North Tyneside, currently attracting and serving 520 pupils from a wide catchment. We are seeking to appoint two teachers to work as part of our team, contribute to the outstanding education, safety, welfare, wellbeing, happiness and behaviour that we strive to achieve for the pupils at our school.

One of the posts is permanent and one is temporary (fixed term for 1 year in the first instance). The posts will be in Key Stage 1 or 2. Both posts will commence in September 2018 and would be suitable for newly, recently qualified or experienced teachers. Visits are welcomed and we have arranged three opportunities for candidates to see the school. The times and dates are:

It is an essential requirement of the selection process to submit a well constructed application form relevant to the job description and **Marine Park First School**. Also be aware that we will not consider late applications or accept applications submitted electronically. We very much look forward to receiving your application no later than 12.30 p.m. on the 20th of April 2018. We are anticipating a high level of interest in these posts. If we have not contacted you within four weeks of the closing date please assume that your application has been unsuccessful.
